

IT Facilities

The plans for infrastructural development are given top priority as the University realizes the correlation between adequate infrastructure and effective teaching – learning. The strategies adopted for ensuring adequate infrastructure are as follows:

*Almost all the departments have LCD projectors, overhead projectors, printers and scanners

Dedicated computing facility:- The computers of the University are connected with printers and scanners wherever required. All the computers have high speed internet facility, The computers and printers of all the departments have software installed in them. The University has software installed in English Language Lab , Computer Lab and Library. Maintenance and up gradation of hardware is also maintained from time to time.

* Smart class room facility is used for better teaching and learning process.

*Campus is having 1 GBPS of high speed internet facility. The University has a 24X7 Wi- Fi facility in the campus for the student and faculty members to avail internet connection . The connectivity through a fully networked campus with state-of-the-art IT infrastructure, computing & communication resources, offers students the facilities of e-mail, net surfing, up/down loading of web based application, besides helping them in preparing projects & seminars.

* The entire campus is monitored by CCTV facility. The CCTV installed at strategic places helps to monitor the campus activities.

*Video conferencing sessions are regularly organized to improve the communication efficiency of the students. This facility is useful in Online teaching also.

*For easier communication, circulars including important notices to students and parents , academic calendar, syllabus, applying online for various courses, online fee payment, exam schedule, exam results, admission details, scholarship details, seminar and conferences details, various facilities in the campus, projects, recruitment details are posted online in the website of the University. Website is regularly updated and restructured time to time.

*IT Skill Development Courses for various faculties are conducted regularly.

*Workshops, awareness programs and training programs for faculty are organized to create awareness on new technology

*Campus interviews are conducted online for the students.

- Biometric system is installed for all the academic and administrative staffs.

*To achieve the three cardinal principles of Education Policy viz., access, equity and quality, facility for SWAYAM classes are introduced. University is one of the partnering institutes of SWAYAM.

- The e-Sanad platform can be accessed by every student through the University website to get the Attestation/Apostille on professional and Personal documents from concerned Document Issuing Authorities (DIA) and Ministry of External Affairs (MEA), Govt. of India.

- Every student can Register in NAD (National Academic Depository) through the University website.

*Review meeting is organized by the Head of the Institution. The committee (Academic, Executive) members and all the Heads of departments make decisions for replacement / up gradation / addition of the existing infrastructure. This meeting is conducted at the beginning of the academic year. In the meeting course requirements, computer – student ratio, budget constraints , working condition of the existing equipment and students grievances are reviewed., If need arises, more meetings are held. Based on the suggestions from Committee members, effective utilization of infrastructure is ensured through appointment of adequate and well qualified staffs.
