The training focused on Jewelry making with wild seeds and Apiculture, both of which utilize local resources abundantly available in the region. Each training session has 25 active participants.

Apiculture training

Venue : Vadakavunji
Date : 17.03.2024 and 19.03.2024
No. of participants : 25



The training focused on Apiculture, a sustainable practice that holds significant potential in the Kodaikanal region. The session was conducted at Vadakavunji and Vadakaraiparai, and the lead trainer, Mr. Karthikeyan from Anu Honey, shared his expertise in beekeeping with the participants. Mr. Karthikeyan then demonstrated the setting up of a bee box, hive management, and the proper handling of bees to ensure safety. Participants were shown how to identify different types of bees, and the methods of extracting honey without disturbing the hive were explained in detail.

Apiculture training

No. of participants: 25



The apiculture training commenced at Vadakaraiparai on March 18, 2024, with Mr. Karthikeyan from Anu Honey leading the session. He introduced the participants to the basics of beekeeping, covering bee box installation, hive management, and honey extraction techniques. The participants were shown how to handle the bees safely and identify different types of bees within the hive. The session was interactive, with participants getting hands-on experience under the guidance of the trainer.

Second day- 20.03.2024 (training was conducted at Vadakaraiparai), where Dr. Usha Raja Nanthini took over the apiculture training. Dr. Usha covered additional aspects of beekeeping, focusing on the ecological importance of bees and their role in maintaining biodiversity in the region.

Environmental Awareness Programme on 09.08.2023 at Vilpatti




