



INTRODUCTION

development needs of joint initiatives that they deem appropriate. This formal understanding (MoU) between MTWU and JSVP Foundation will underpin and support in conducting "A Certificate Course on Law and Gender" for the Department & Centre for Women's Studies, Mother Teresa Women's University.

PURPOSE AND SCOPE

The purpose of this MOU is to provide the framework arrangement between MTWU and JSVP Foundation that covers initiatives and the development of relationships with:

The benefit of the MOU is that both MTWU and JSVP Foundation will have a clear framework within which to make the best practice decisions that support and enhance their respective organisations.

The benefit to potential beneficiaries and students is that their relationship with MTWU and JSVP Foundation is seamless as both organisations work together to deliver a high quality beneficiary experience.

1. STATUS OF THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

1.1 This Document is not intended to be legally binding.

1.2 This Document may be basis for the preparation of formal contracts or agreements between the parties. For the purpose of implementing each specific contract or agreement of activity, both institutions shall prepare the necessary documentation which shall be the object of a Specific Agreement or Contract to be executed by the concerned parties.

1.3 The parties do not enter into any legal relationship unless and until such formal contracts or agreements are executed.

2. OBJECTIVE OF THE MoU


The University has intended to provide "A Certificate Course on Law and Gender" in collaboration with JSVP Foundation.


The parties have had preliminary discussions in this matter and have ascertained areas of broad consensus. The parties now therefore agreed to enter in writing these areas of consensus under a Memorandum of Understanding.

Now this Memorandum of Understanding witnesses that:

The University shall offer the said course either semester or non semester pattern as decided by the University but should complete 90 hours.

The above tuition fees/other fees of the respective courses may be revised as and when required by the mutual consent of the University and JSVP Foundation.

The above said course shall be conducted in the University premises and its affiliated or constituent colleges as per norms in accord to the resolutions made in the Board of studies.

The above said course can also be conducted in the premises of JSVP Foundation.

3. ADMISSION PROCEDURE:

- a. Application and prospectus bearing the seal and logo of the Mother Teresa Women's University shall be prepared with the approval of the University, printed at their cost and sold by JSVP Foundation, or through the University or the Department concerned (Department and Centre for Women's Studies)
- b. Filled – in applications from the prospective candidates will be received by the University or its colleges.
- c. The fees to be collected from the students selected and approved by the University through Demand Draft.

ACADEMIC PROGRAMMES – COURSES OF STUDY

The course materials shall be provided by JSVP Foundation only and will be submitted for its approval from the University.

1.1 TUITION FEES

The fee structure prescribed for the programmes are as follows:

The cost of application for admission to the courses of study specified supra will be Rs.150/-and shall be in the form of Demand Draft drawn in favour of "The Registrar, Mother Teresa Women's University" Kodaikanal-624 101.

The tuition fees fixed by the University and collected by JSVP Foundation on behalf of the University shall be shared on the ratio or 40:60 between Mother Teresa Women's University and JSVP Foundation. The fee shall be collected from the students by JSVP Foundation will be submitted to the University in the form of demand drafts drawn in favour of "The Registrar, Mother Teresa Women's University, Kodaikanal-624 101".

The share due to JSVP Foundation will be paid by the University on submission of Demand Drafts along with filled in applications within a month from the last date for receipt of filled – in applications and Demand Drafts for admission.

1.2 EXAMINATION

The University shall closely monitor the programmes offered at JSVP Foundation and takes appropriate measures to ensure the quality of the agreed programmes. Dates and

appropriate time during the semester/ non semester. The centers of examination and valuation of answer scripts and centers for practical shall be decided by the University. The panel of Examiners for Question Paper setting, Valuation and Practical Examination will be provided by JSVP Foundation. University has the right to modify and select the Examiners from the Panel for conducting theory and Practical Examinations. Examination fees will be fixed by the University as per the norms approved by the competent body of the University. The fees shall be paid in the form of demand Draft drawn in favour of "Mother Teresa Women's University, Kodaikanal -624 101". the form of demand Draft drawn in favour of "Mother Teresa Women's University, Kodaikanal -624 101".

3. COORDINATION AND MANAGEMENT

3.1 To fulfil the aims and objectives of the MoU, each party shall appoint a Coordinator to develop and manage the joint activities undertaken, specific details of which will be set out in formal agreements. Any such formal agreements shall include:

- a. The responsibilities of each party
- b. An outline schedule of each activity
- c. A budget and sources of finance for each activity
- d. Management details for the delivery of each activity
- e. Other services deemed appropriate for successful implementation of the above

4. PROMOTIONAL MATERIAL

4.1 All the promotional materials used by either party relating to this MoU must be submitted to the authorized representative of the other party for approval in writing prior to publication.

4.2 The authorised representatives for approval are set out below:




5. DURATION AND TERMINATION

5.3 Either party may at any time terminate the MoU by the giving of 60 days written notice.


6. RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

Nothing contained in this Document shall be construed as constituting a joint venture, partnership, formal service arrangement of any kind between the parties or of appointing either party as an agent of the other.


7. VARIATION


This MoU may be varied or amended by mutual consent of the parties in writing and such variation or amendment shall become part of this MoU upon the giving of that consent.


