Preamble

2. MTWU, Mibot, and UNITAR shall work collaboratively to facilitate faculty and student exchange programs.
3. The Parties agree to jointly organize academic and professional development events.
4. Each Party shall ensure proper intellectual property rights and confidentiality regarding exchanged materials.

The following is the successful co-operation between the three parties hereby confirms their wish to the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on education and training. Both institutions agree to the development of joint activities to address the issues of mutual interest designed to foster and promote collaboration in the field of education and training through the following activities to promote the Robotics.

Role of MTWU:

1. MTWU Institute shall facilitate the assigned venue and use their class room, lecture halls/ auditorium for managing training infrastructure with the mutual consent of trio the parties whereas Mibot will support the facilitation of the training programs.
2. Coordinate with Mibot and UNITAR to organize and conduct training sessions.
3. MTWU will ensure that Mibot provides all the necessary resources and support to Party
4. MTWU nominates **Dr S Meena Priya dharshini, Head and Director i/c in Department and Centre or Women's Studies** and **Dr. K. Kavitha, Assistant Professor of Computer Science** as a Coordinating / Liaison Officers for communication and coordination with MiBot and UNITAR.

Role of Mibot & UNITAR:

1. Provide robotic products and resources for hands-on student learning.
2. Offer specialized training, Internships and workshops in robotics for students and faculty.
3. Support knowledge exchange by collaborating on robotics education programs.
4. Facilitate research initiatives focused on robotics innovation and education.
5. Ensure access to Mibot's technological tools and training materials, enabling Students to experiment and innovate in a practical learning environment.
6. MiBOT will provide study material to each participant.
7. After completing the Evaluation / Assessment Criteria, the certificate will be prepared & issued by MiBot to successful trainees after received the complete details of the trainees from MTWU and UNITAR
8. The Banners and Invitation will be prepared by Mibot for this proposed training programmes

Implementation and Review

- The Parties shall discuss and mutually agree on specific programs and implementation plans. This MoU shall be reviewed periodically to ensure its effectiveness and relevance.

Duration and Termination

This MoU shall remain in effect for a period of five (5) years from the date of signing unless extended by mutual consent. Any Party may terminate this MoU by providing written notice at least three (3) months in advance.

Governing Law

This MoU shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the respective jurisdictions of the Parties.

Confidentiality

The Parties acknowledge that during collaboration, confidential information may be disclosed. Trio Parties agree to maintain the confidentiality of such information and not disclose it to third parties without prior written consent, except as required by law.
