MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

BETWEEN

MOTHER TERESA WOMEN'S UNIVERSITY
KODAIKANAL – 624101, DINDIGUL DISTRICT, TAMILNADU, INDIA

AND

ARASU COLLEGE OF ARTS AND SCIENCE FOR WOMEN
(Affiliated to Bharathidasan University, Tiruchirappalli)
PANDUTHAKARANPUDUR, MANMANGALAM, KARUR-639 006

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING is made this day of 30, August, 2024
(hereinafter referred to as "MoU")

Mother Teresa Women's University (MTWU) and Arasu College of Arts and Science for Women, wish to establish mutual relations and agree to collaborate with each other as follows:

Collaboration shall be carried out through such activities as

1. Exchange of faculty
2. Students Internship
3. Joint research activities and publications
4. Organizing seminars, workshops, conference, webinars and academic meetings
5. Exchange of academic materials and other information

The terms of collaboration for each specific activity implemented under this MoU shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both Institutions prior to the initiation of that activity. Any such MoU's entered into, as outlined above, will form appendices to this MoU for Collaboration.

I. STUDENT INTERNSHIP

1. Student Internship in the University Department will be provided on payment basis.
2. Transportation, accommodation, food, clothing and other personal costs including medical care will be the personal responsibilities of the students themselves.
3. The host University shall reserve or make available accommodation on campus for exchange students on payment basis or assist them in locating suitable housing off campus if they so desire.
4. Any Intellectual Property developed during the joint activity will be jointly owned by the two Institutions.

II. FACULTY EXCHANGE

1. The two Institutions will actively seek to promote mutual faculty exchange to act as resource persons for conferences, seminars and special lectures and research.
2. The two Institutions acknowledge that in the absence of an external funding agency, all expenses for travel, living and allied costs will be left to the discretion and the responsibility of the home Institution.
3. Any Intellectual Property developed during the joint activity will be jointly owned by the two Institutions.

III. EXTENSION OF RESEARCH FACILITIES

Research facilities like laboratories, instruments etc. can be utilized on payment basis as decided by the host University

IV. EXCHANGE OF INFORMATION

Information will be actively exchanged, including information for students, information on research and study provided at the University, relevant information about faculty members and fields of research, and University publications.

V. CONFIDENTIALITY AND PRIVACY

Mother Teresa Women's University, Kodaikanal and Arasu College of Arts and Science For Women recognize that they will come into possession of information which the other considers to be confidential, including Personal Information (Personal Information means information and opinions recorded in any form about an individual whose identity is apparent, or can reasonably be ascertained from the information or opinion). Mother Teresa Women's University and Arasu College of Arts and Science For Women agree that it shall not, at any time, disclose to any third party, any confidential information of another party without first having obtained the prior written consent of the other party. The provisions of this Clause are intended to and shall be binding upon the parties upon the signing of this MoU, and shall survive till the termination or expiry of this MoU.

VI. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

Intellectual Property means and includes all copyright, all rights in relation to inventions (including patent rights), plant varieties, registered and unregistered trademarks, registered and unregistered designs and all other rights resulting from intellectual activity in the scientific, industrial, literary or artistic fields.

Each party shall retain all rights to existing intellectual property belonging to it and contributed by it ("Background IP") at the commencement of each Research Project arising under this agreement.

If any IPR issue emerges as a result of joint research, then a specific IPR addendum will be jointly agreed upon.

VII. USE OF NAME AND LOGO

No party shall use, nor permit any person or entity to use, the name (or logo or any variation thereof) of another party without first obtaining prior written consent from the other party. The parties intend that this provision shall be upon them and shall survive till the termination or expiry of this MoU.

VII TERMS OF IMPLEMENTATION, RENEWAL, REVISION, CANCELLATION AND NOTICES

1. Details of the implementation of any particular exchange resulting from this MoU shall be negotiated between the two Institutions.
2. This MoU becomes effective on the day it is signed and remains valid for five years.
3. This MoU will be renewed after five years upon the consent in writing of both Institutions. Each Institution may cancel the MoU by notifying the other, of its intend to do so at least six months in advance of its expiration.
4. Any amendment or modification to the present text shall be submitted for review to the competent authorities, and shall not bind unless reduced to writing and signed by both the Institutions.
5. Nothing in this MoU shall be construed as creating any legal relationships between the Parties. This MoU is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration.
